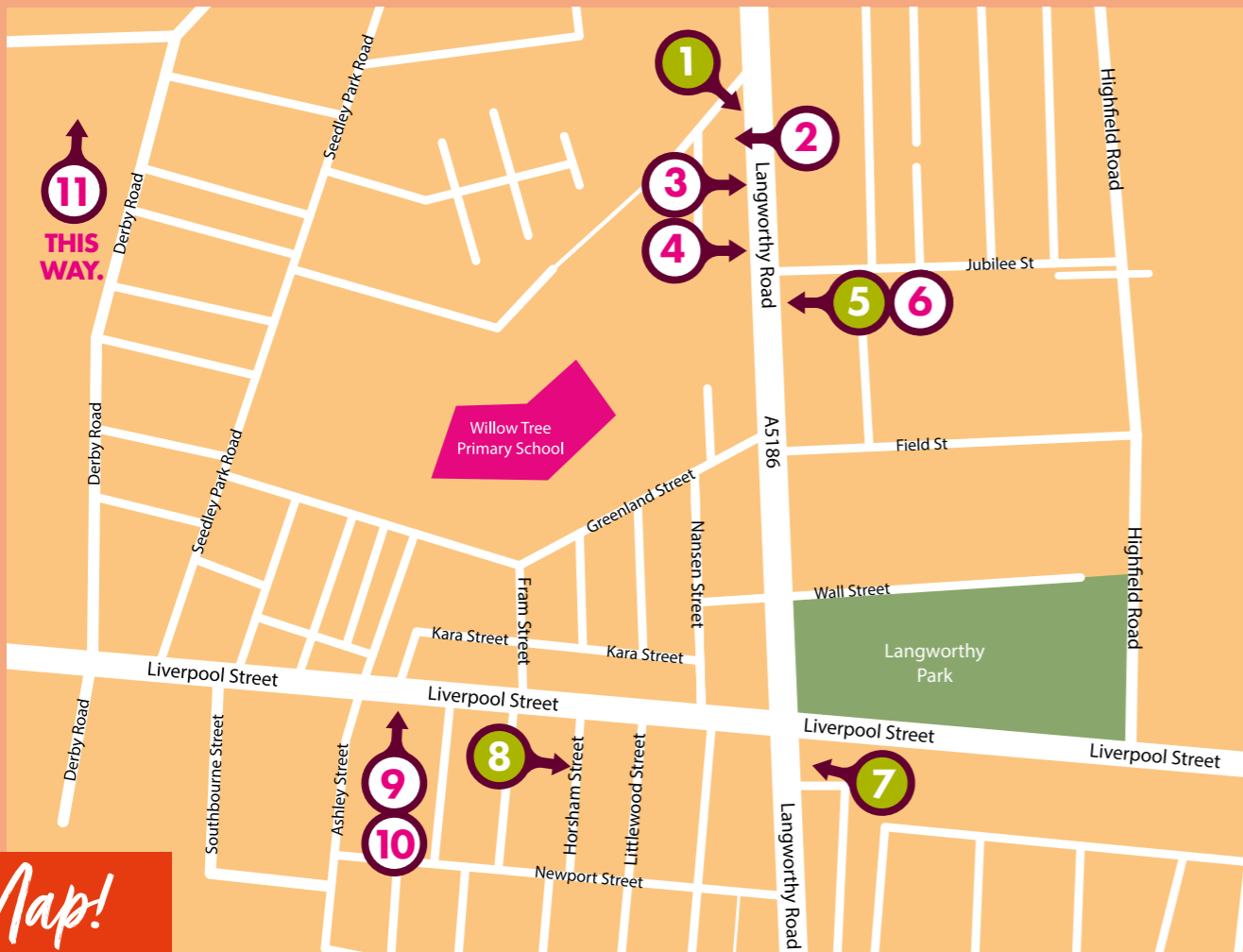

What is Langworthy Live?

Langworthy Live is a music festival, but not like you might imagine it. Situated in the heart of Salford, we are bringing together people, music and a lot of fun to the high street.

The festival works with local musicians, dancers, poets, and other acts, and hosts them inside the local high street shops and businesses. Over the years we've put music simultaneously in the local allotment, a dry cleaners, the barbers, an old sweet shop, the pub and the church hall. We've had a harpist, a teenager doing their first 'proper' gig, and a rock band, all playing next to each other and cheering each other on. It's creative, it's supportive, and it's a little bit bonkers - just the way we like it!

Use this programme to find your next favourite band, to visit a shop that you've never been to and to explore our wonderful community of Langworthy.

Show your wristband to the volunteers on the door at any or all of the venues throughout the day, and feel free to stay as long or as short as you like. We have all kinds of performances at Langworthy Live, so there is something for everyone.

Please remember that this is a volunteer led festival, with all acts performing for free. Be kind, cheer loudly, buy a pint and support the local businesses in your community.

If you want to eat a meal while you are here, you are welcome to use one of the picnic spots marked out on the map to eat your own food or something from a local shop.
